AASHTO M 180

Task Force Update

- Developing recommended revisions to the M-180-25 standard [current status]
- Submitting proposed red-line revisions to AASHTO COMP TS 4d by May 2025
- TS 4d to review and ballot Spring/Summer, then discuss during their in-person meeting in Aug 2025
- Approved TS 4d changes then balloted by all of COMP in Oct/Nov 2025
- Approved changes to be published in AASHTO Materials Standards Book in July 2026

- MASH Test Level 4
 - 42-inch concrete movable barrier
- MASH Test Level 3
 - Non-gating W-beam guardrail end terminal
 - Longitudinal barrier comprised of E-glass Fiber Reinforced Polymer
 - Flared, single sided W-Beam guardrail end terminal
 - Redirective, non-gating, energy-absorbing crash cushion
 - Steel-jacketed concrete barrier
- MASH Test Level 2
 - Sustainable rubber barrier made from 95% recycled waste tires
- New guardrail tools
- Barrier systems for urban settings
